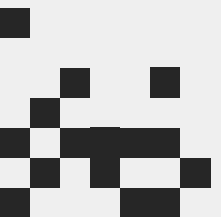
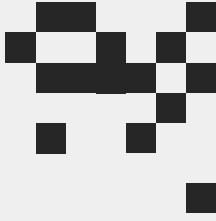
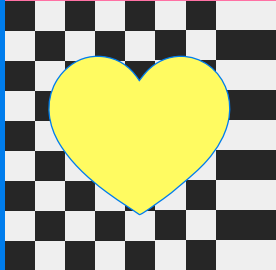
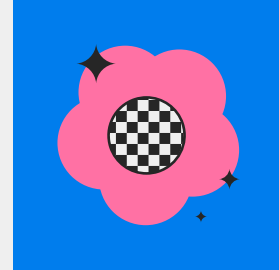
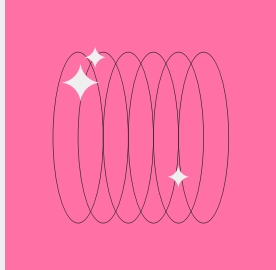
# GLOW DAY
