
Indigenous Hand Games

Thank you Mrs. Holly Janvier-Crookedneck for teaching our Grade 2 students traditional Indigenous Hand games - it was so much fun!

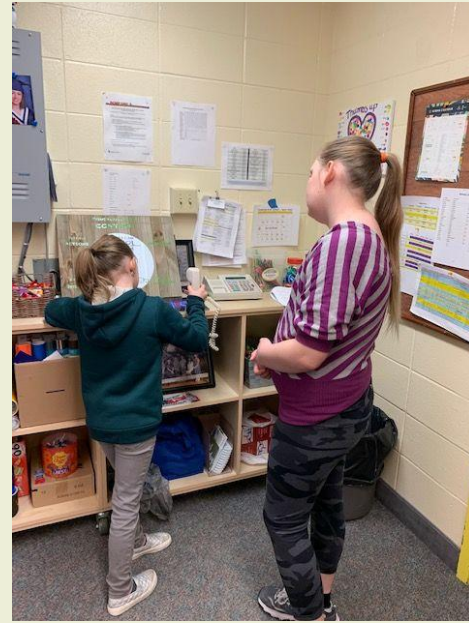
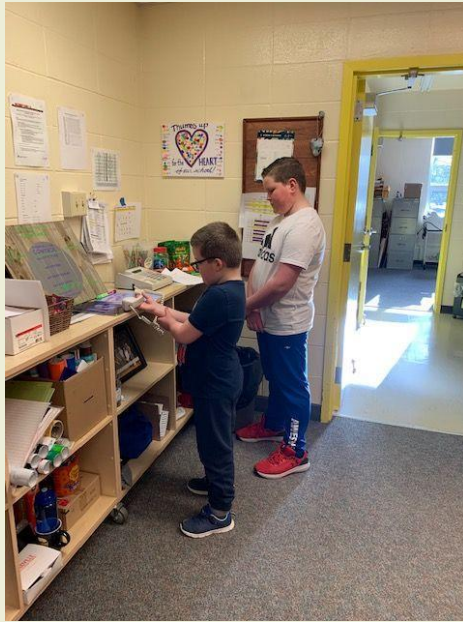

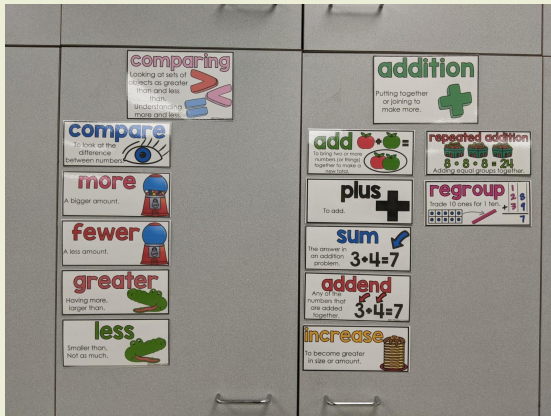
NUMERACY



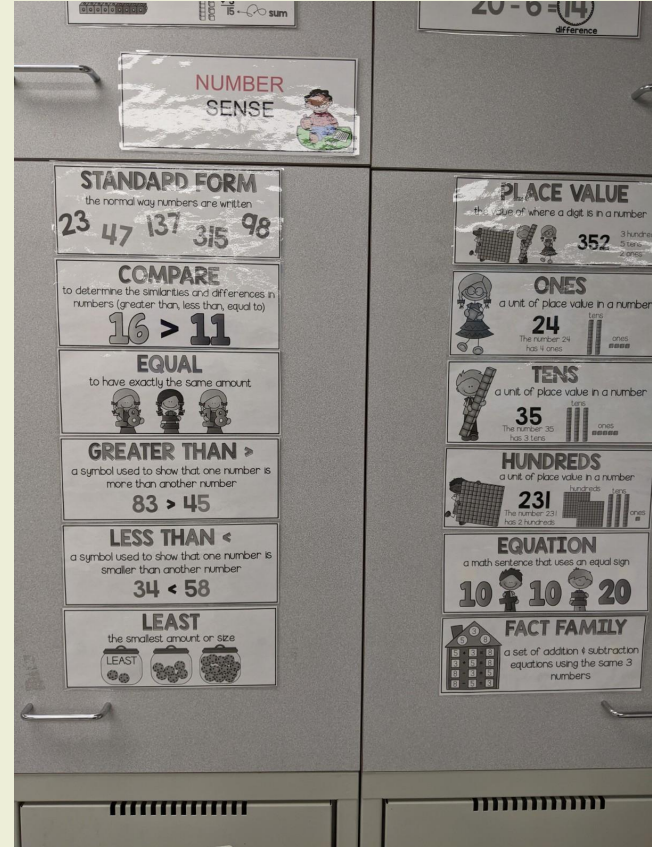
