What is your favorite part of the Future Goals™ program? How do you see STEM in the game of hockey?

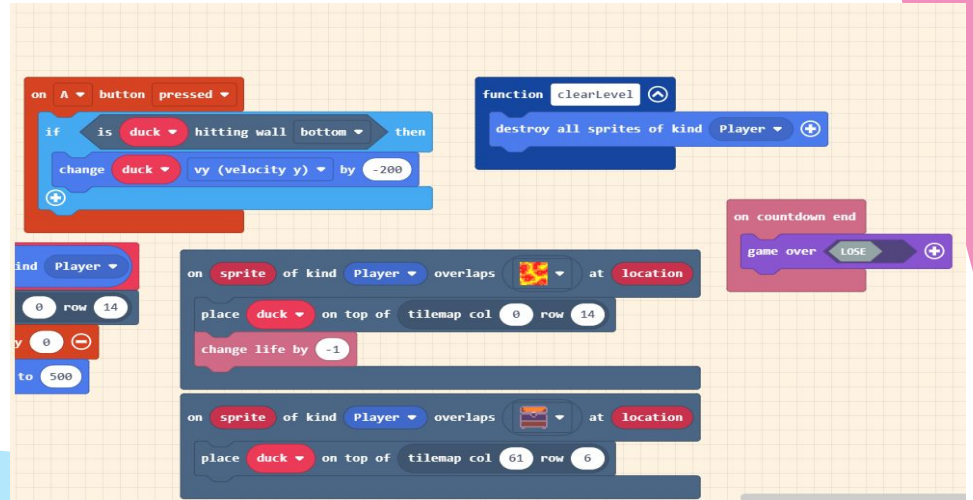

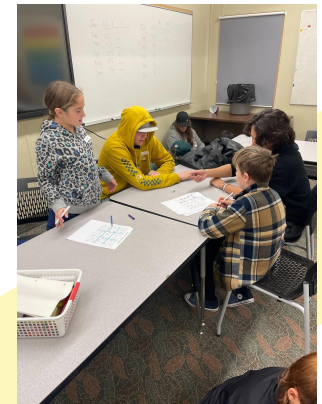


BIG BUDDIES

We have partnered with BCHS to provide our Grade 4 students with an opportunity to build connections with a high school student through a Big Buddies program.

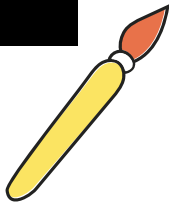
Although we reach out to our kids as staff and build positive relationships, this takes it to another level. For some kids, this is the best part of their year. They will create great memories together.

The high school students spend time before their first visit preparing activities to do with their buddy. It's a great leadership activity for them. This partnership is a win-win for both sides.

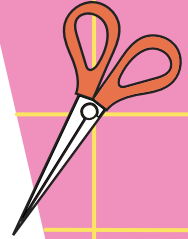
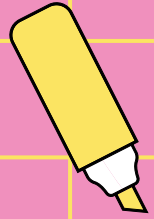


RESPECT

Glendon School celebrated the 50th day of school with lots of fun activities! We participated in activities from the 50's such as jiving, hula hooping, and listening to 50's music.

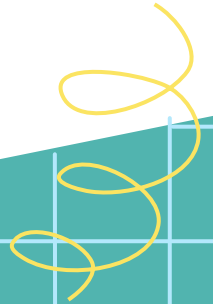
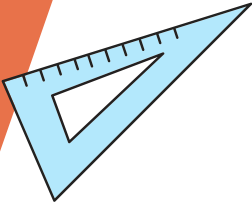


Mathematics was incorporated throughout the day. Students practiced counting to 50 in a variety of ways such as counting money, tallies, ten frames and other math manipulatives.

Currently, 10 EA's are running daily groups with 2-3 students. We are excited to see the results!





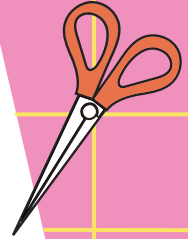
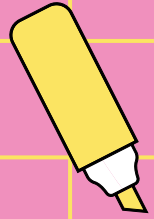

HEB was excited to host our bus drivers and offer them some home baked treats after their morning bus routes this month.

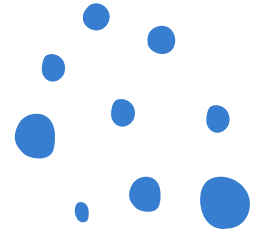


School Councils from HEB, Duclos and BCBS gave each bus driver a gift card as a thank you for all that they do to do keep our students safe while transporting them to and from school daily.

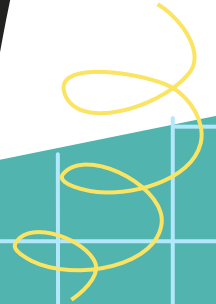
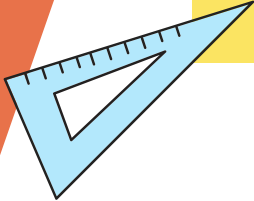

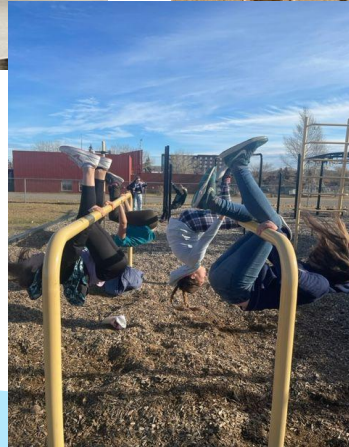
