


Art Smith Aviation Academy hosted their annual meet the teacher night.



























Staff and students gathered for a special visit and book reading from our good friend, Setsunè Lynda in honour of Truth & Reconciliation Day














### 02 **Aurora** Middle **School**

At Aurora every homeroom has a large bin that is filled once a week with fresh fruit. Students cannot learn when they are hungry, and our fruit bins are integral to promoting wellness at AMS. We have a system where classes sign up to wash fruit and this also helps grow our appreciation of having fruit. When the fruit arrives on Mondays it is washed and distributed to classes by the class in charge for that week. Students can then help themselves to fruit whenever they are hungry. Our fruit bins cost approximately \$1,500-2,000 a month.




## 16 Vera M. Welsh **Elementary School**
