

# **Seven Teachings Award**

#### Overview

This award is designed to encourage and recognize First Nations, Metis and Inuit students who demonstrate dedication in pursuit of their educational path, rooted in cultural pride and growth.

# Eligibility

Nominees must meet the following criteria to be eligible for an award:

- 1. Must be enrolled as a student in an NLPS school in the year in which they are nominated.
- 2. Must be identified as a First Nations, Metis or Inuit learner, as indicated on page 2 of the NLPS Student Registration Form.
- 3. Must have a signed FOIP consent form on file authorizing NLPS to recognize them as a recipient of the award.

#### **Award Criteria**

Nominees must demonstrate one or more of the following:

- 1. Truth, love, respect, courage, humility, wisdom, and honesty;
- 2. Perseverance in pursuit of their goals;
- 3. Embracing their cultural identity and promoting the strength, beauty and value of their culture and community;
- 4. Modelling leadership through a cultural lens that inspires other to pursue their goals;
- 5. Consistency and/or growth in work ethic, attitude, and interaction with others.

# **Categories**

NLPS will recognize a minimum of one student at each school on an annual basis.

# **Nomination Process**

Students may self-nominate or be nominated by staff, students, parents or community members.

Nomination packages must include:

- A completed nomination form;
- Supporting documentation outlining how the student meets the criteria for the award (maximum of three pages); and
- A letter of support from an NLPS school staff member (administrator, counsellor, teacher, educational assistant, etc.) (maximum of three pages).

### **Nomination Deadline**

Nominations must be received by April 1. Nominations can be submitted online at (put link to awards page), emailed to (email address) or mailed to NLPS.

# **Procedures**

- Nominations will be reviewed by the Boards' awards committee prior to April 30th.
- 2. Schools and award recipients will be notified in May and arrangements will be made to present the award at a school assembly or awards ceremony.
